

Rail x Rail Installation Guide (05.01.26)

(Warning, this installation process requires jailbreaking your device. If you are uncomfortable with this process, please remove all personal information and wipe your device before starting this process).

Step 1. Requirements:

Access to a Windows, Mac OS, or Linux device.

Rail x Rail .ipa file, located at:<https://archive.org/details/railx-rail-1.1.5/> (download it)

3uTools App (available on Windows, Mac OS, or Linux). Download at: <https://www.3u.com/>

One of the following:

iPad 2 (Model Number: A1395, A1396, A1397)

iPad 3 (A1403, A1416, A1430)

iPad 4 (A1458, A1459)

(Model number is located in the lower center of the back of the iPad)

Example:



Charging cable for device used: Either 30-Pin cable or Lightning cable. (iPad 2 & 3 use a 30-pin, iPad 4 uses a lightning charger).

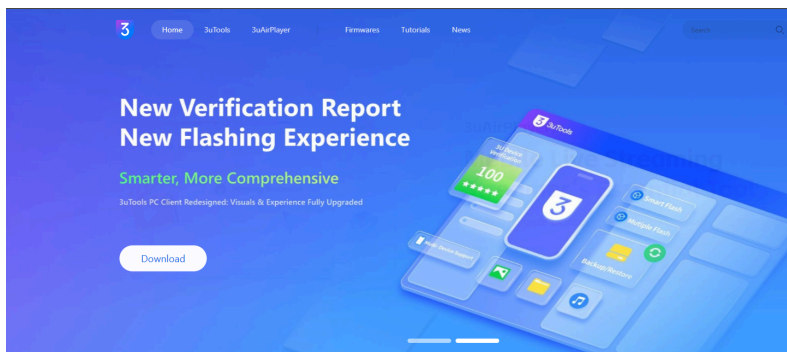
Installation Steps:

1. Meeting previously mentioned requirements
2. Preparing your tools
3. Jailbreaking the ipad
4. Downloading necessary extensions on the ipad
5. Uploading .ipa file onto the ipad

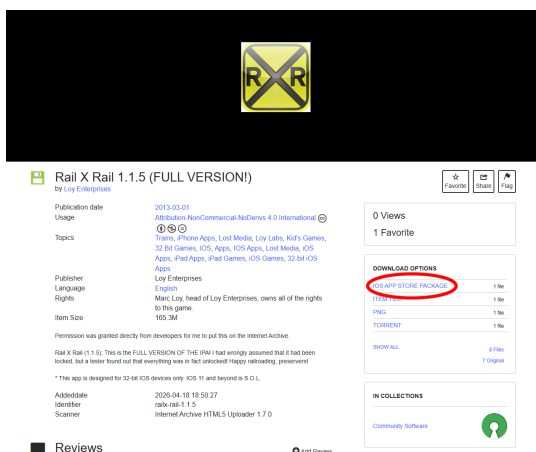
2. Preparing your tools

Before starting the jailbreaking process, make sure the following are downloaded:

Download “3uTtools” - (on your computer)



Download the RailxRail .ipa file - (on your computer) <https://archive.org/details/railx-rail-1.1.5/>
Click the top download option labeled “iOS App Store package”



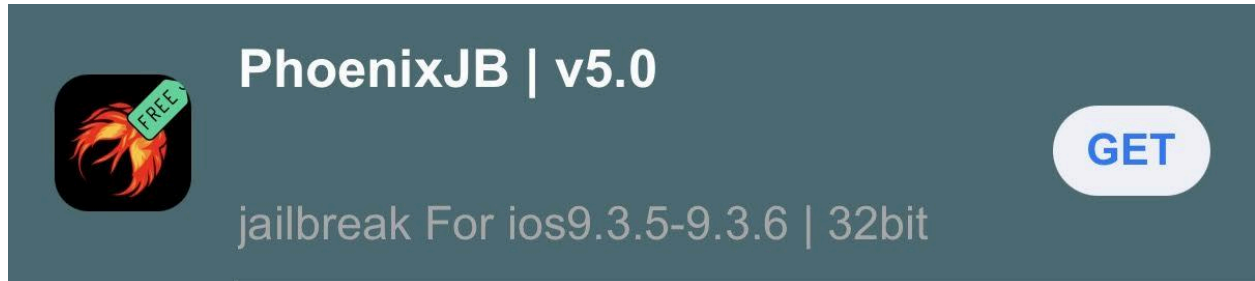
Plug in the iPad into the computer via 30-Pin or Lightning cable, and confirm the device has a stable connection. Click “Trust” on the iPad when prompted. Confirm the iPad appears in 3uTools. (it should show device information by default).

3. The jailbreaking process

On safari on iPad navigate to "ipa-apps.me"

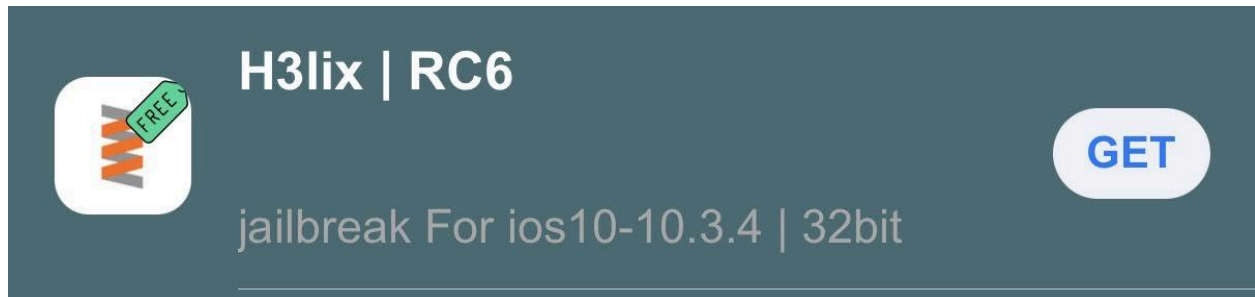
On iPad 2 & iPad 3: Click "**GET**" on "**PhoenixJB | v5.0**"

(it should show version **iOS 9.3.5 - 9.3.6 | 32-bit**)

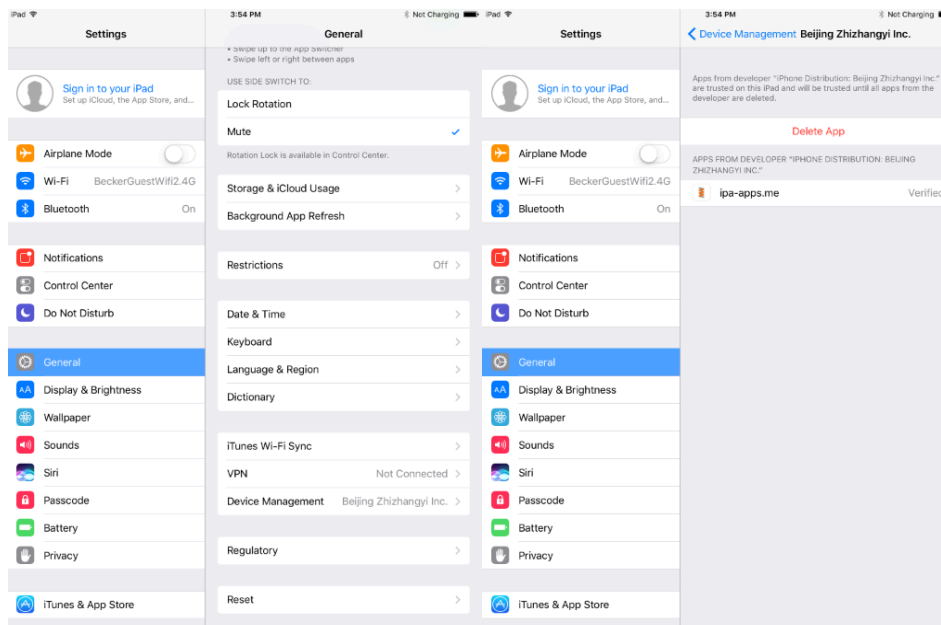


On iPad 4: Click "**GET**" on "**H3lix | RC6**"

(it should show versions **iOS 10.0.0 - 10.3.4 | 32-bit**)



After clicking "**GET**" you should be redirected to another tab that says "skip ad" then a prompt for "**install**" should appear, click install, and either the "**H3lix**" or "**PhoenixJB**" should appear. Next, navigate to **Settings > General > Device Management**, and click "**Allow app**"



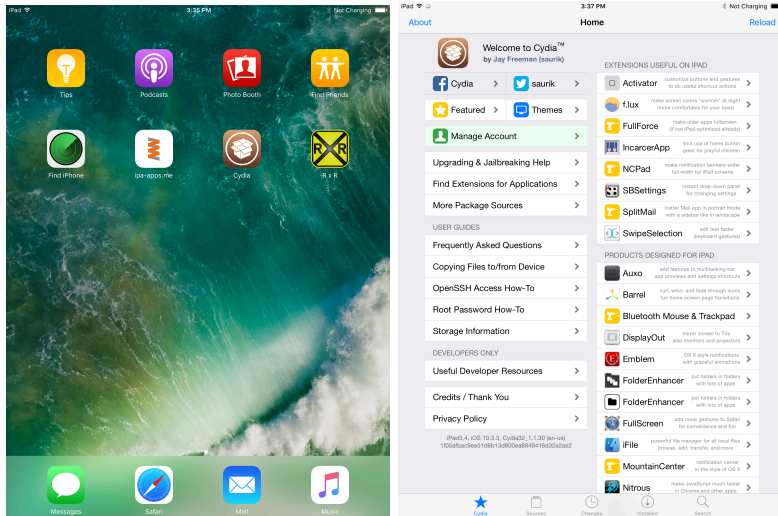
Go back to **H3lix/PhoenixJB**. Click on the app, then click **“Jailbreak”**.



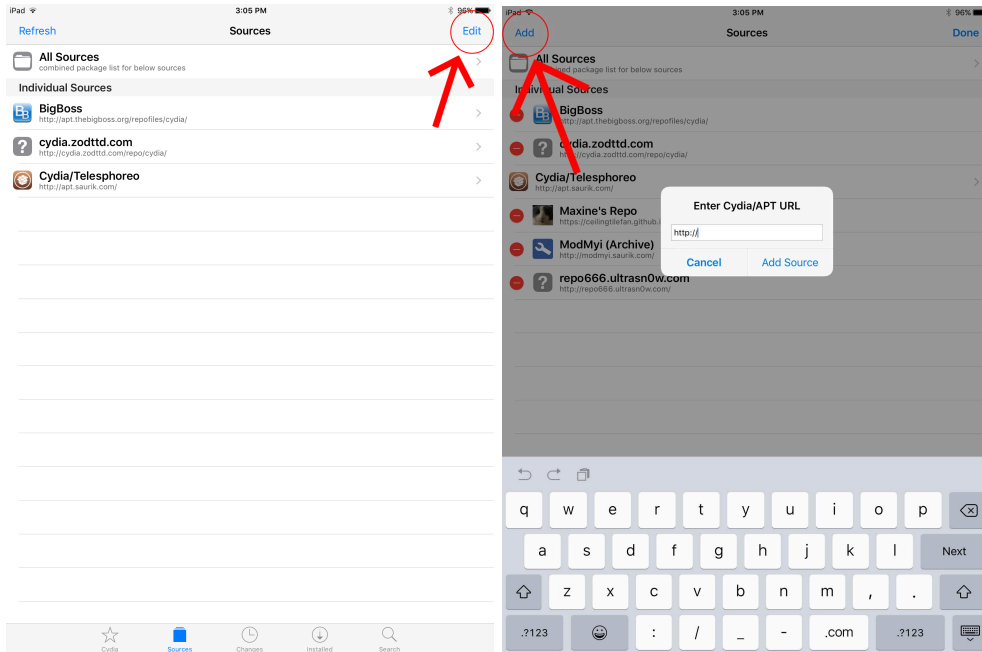

(Button will say jailbreak the first time it is clicked)

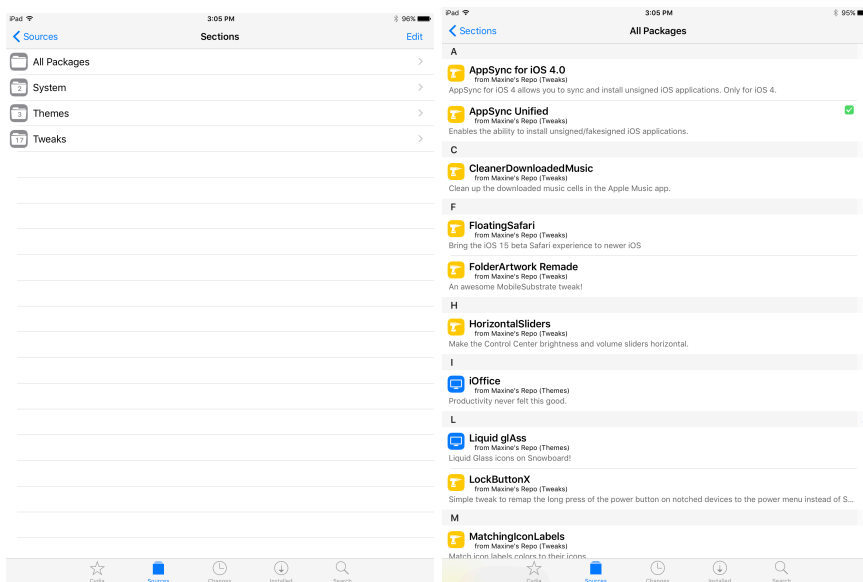
After clicking “jailbreak”, another app (**Cydia**) should appear. Click on **Cydia**. Once in **Cydia** you should see an app that looks like the image below. If you are prompted to download more packages/extensions, download them.



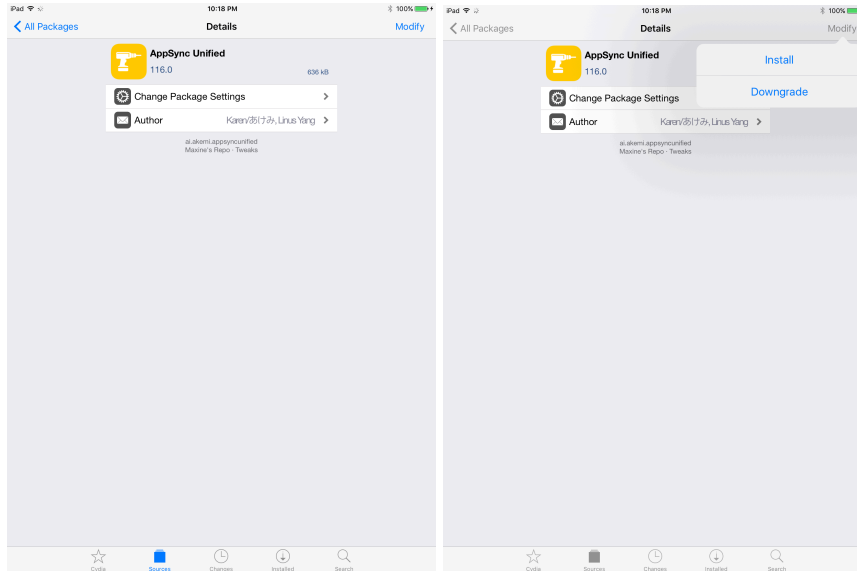
Click **"Sources"** (second button from the left on the bottom) then click **"Edit"**. After clicking edit, click **"Add"** and a URL box will appear on the screen. Add the URL <https://ceilingtilefan.github.io/repo> to the box, then click **"Add Source"**. Upon entering the URL, it should download the **Packages** and prompt you to **"Return to Cydia"** upon completion.



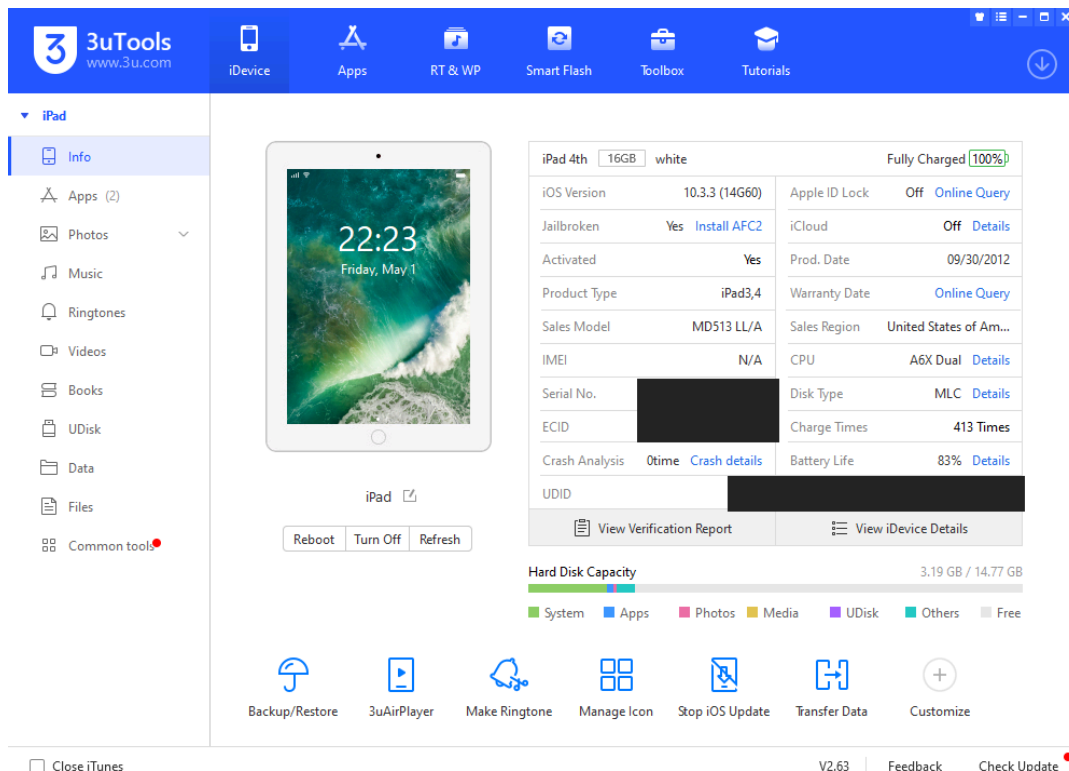
After the download is complete, click **"Done"** in the top right corner, then click on the **Source** titled **"Maxine's Repo"**. Then click **"All Packages"** at the top of the list.



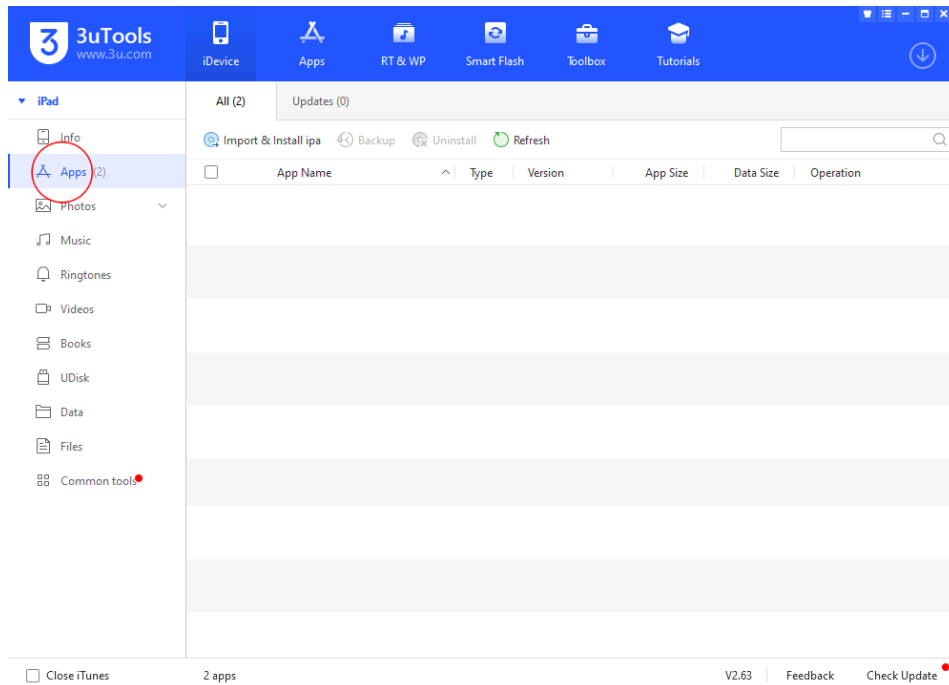
Once on the **All Packages** list, click **“AppSync Unified”**, click **“Modify”** in the top right corner, then click **“Install”**, and **“Confirm”** install. Upon completion the device should restart.



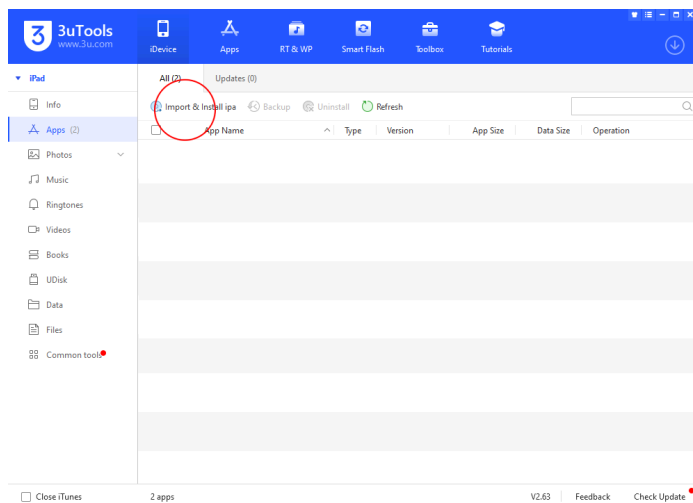
Now, on a computer (Windows/Mac OS/Linux), open **“3uTools”**, and ensure the iPad appears as such:



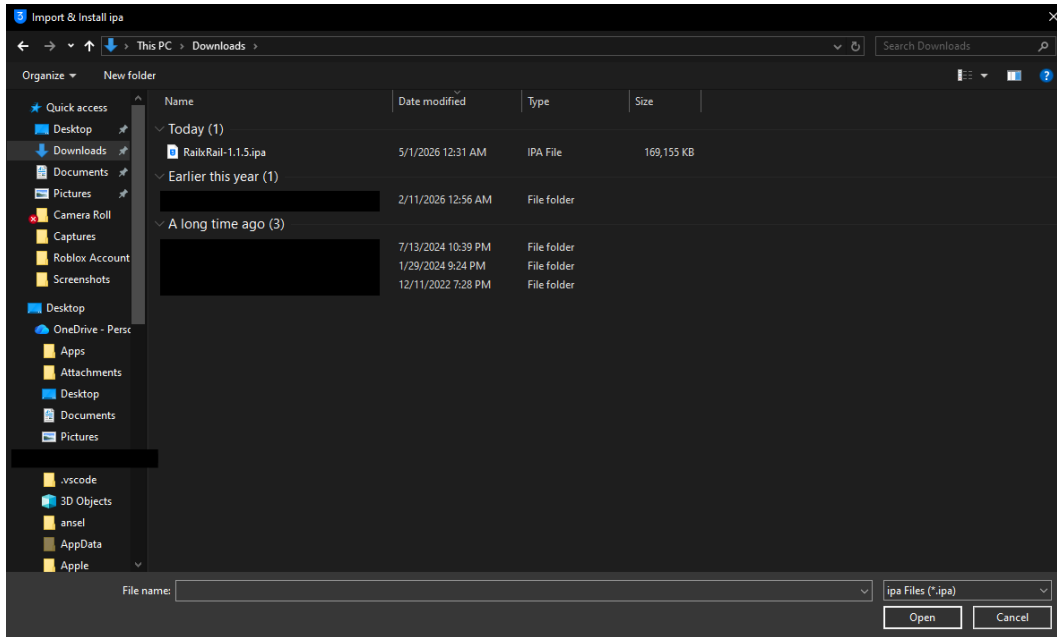
Now, from the tabs on the left, click **“Apps”**



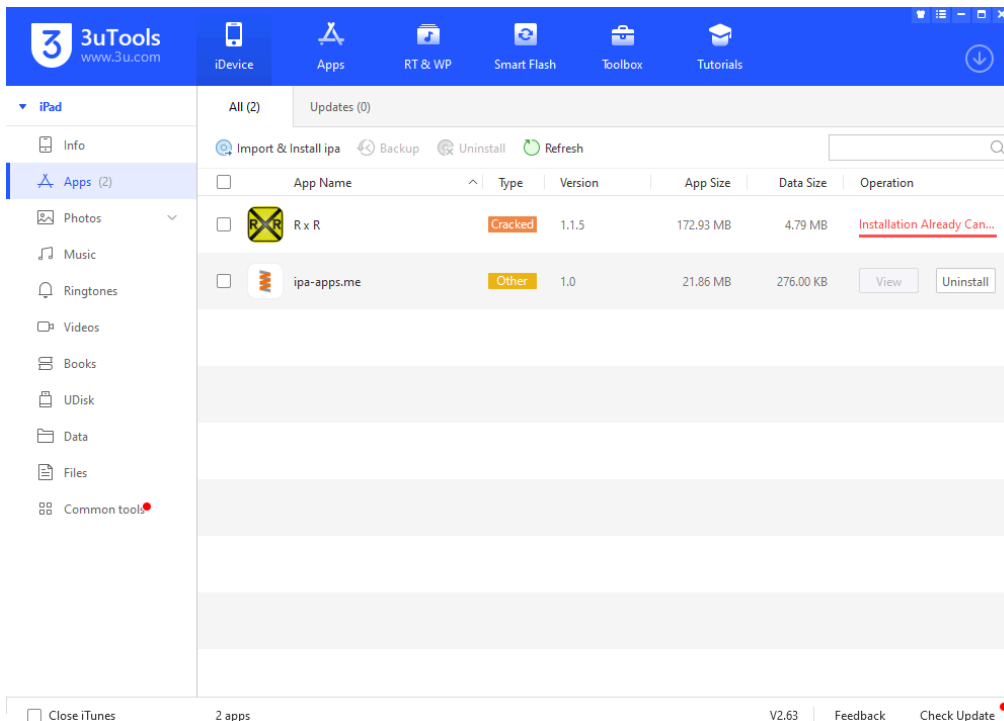
Next click **“Import & Install ipa”** in the tab.



Next, select the “RailxRail-1.1.5.ipa” file from downloads, and select “Open”.



Upon clicking “Open”, the app should start downloading onto the iPad. Once complete, the game should be fully playable. (In this case I already have it downloaded and do not want to wipe the app and download again, disregard the red text saying “Installation Already Cancelled”).



Now, Rail X Rail should be playable on your iPad 🤖
